





The car only consumes 2.5€ /100 km in urban thoroughfare. The vehicle will be out in the market in March 2012 urban thoroughfare.



Movie of the month

The Adventures of Tintin: Secret of the Unicorn

It all starts when Tintin finds a ship mockup that contains a great secret. From this point, Tintin will be taken around the world with the help of Captain Haddock and his dog Snowy. The plot is based on The Secret of the Unicorn although elements from other adventures appear. Steven Spielberg discovered Tintin back in the 80s and he started thinking about the idea of a movie. However, it hasn't been until now that both schedule and technology breakthroughs have



made it possible. There is no doubt that this movie has been a technological challenge; Spielberg calls this specific technique "performance capture", first seen in Polar Express by Robert Zemeckis. The goal was not only to make a Tintin movie but also to




recreate Hergé's hand-to-.paper art, this is why Spielberg asked Peter Jackson (Lord of the Rings) and his animation company, Weta Digital, for help.






Movie of the month



This has been quite an experience for Spielberg due to the fact that this is his first animated film as well as his first 3D production. In terms of aesthetics, the most important thing was the colour palette, when Hergé drew the comic he created the style known as ligne claire or clear line, making Tintin's face simple and elegant on paper.

Spielberg and Jackson wanted to show this style and they spent between two and three years developing just the face. Actually, the technological preparation took almost five years while the shooting only took 31 days. After the face was finished, they looked for an actor with, as Jackson says, "Tintinish qualities"; they found Jamie Bell whose movements and voice will be Tintin's.



















Halloween

Halloween is a holiday celebrated on October 31st. It has its origin in Ireland and the British Islands. Back in the time, the Celts considered this night to be the last of the year and the beginning of the winter.





It was a very special night, perfect for supernatural activities such as fortune telling. Legend says that the line separating the underworld and our world was blurry that night and the Lord of Darkness allowed the spirits to cross the boundary so that they could walk among us. Through the years, a lot of traditions have been created:


Jack O'Lantern: this is the name given to a pumpkin with a carved face and a light inside, usually these are placed in the





houses so that children know where to stop.

Trick or treat: children in scary costumes go from door to door asking for candy. The word *trick* refers to a practical joke on the owner of the house where they don't get their treat, that is, their candy.



Costumes: not only children dress up this night, a lot of adults go to Halloween parties and dress up as any kind of spooky creature.



Movie marathons: more and more often, TV channels have their Halloween marathons, not only they put scary movies but also special programs, even for children.

Burgos

As I was walking along its cold streets, I could feel the importance of the city in the history of our country, from the times of Alfonso III the Great

to the enlightened despotism, from the Visigoths to the Spanish Civil war. Burgos combines historical monuments with modern architecture making the city a perfect location for a cultural day trip.



The Burgos Cathedral is a must in your visit, whether you are an art fan or not, you will appreciate the construction, both the façade, inspired by the pure French Gothic style, and the treasures found inside. This magnificent building is the only Spanish cathedral declared as a World Heritage Site by UNESCO. One of the greatest attractions of the building besides the architecture is the presence of the tomb of El Cid and Doña Jimena as well as a very peculiar articulated statue called the Flycatcher.



Another UNESCO World Heritage Site situated close to the city is the Archaeological Site of Atapuerca, 10 miles from this impressive location, in the city, you can visit the Museum of Human Evolution where you

can find faithful reproductions of the mountains in which you will see some of the most important human fossil finds in the world.



Burgos is a very attractive city for tourists of all ages, if you happen to go there with your children, take a ride in the touristic train that goes around the whole city explaining some interesting facts about the different areas. Perfect to go sightseeing, just one tip: wear some warm clothes!



COOKING CORNER

Maryland crab cakes

Ingredients

150 g crabmeat

3 slices sliced bread

50 ml milk

1 teaspoon mayonnaise 2 eggs

50g parsley

1 onion

1 teaspoon yeast

Flour

Butter

Oil

Salt

Pepper

For Soho sauce

100ml mayonnaise

50 ml ketchup

20 ml Dijon mustard

Put the crabmeat in a small bowl, cover with the crumbed sliced bread and soak with half a cup of milk. In a large container thoroughly mix in the mayonnaise, eggs, parsley, chopped onion, yeast, a pinch of salt and pepper and add the soaked crab meat. Work the mixture until it becomes a homogenous paste and then split into ten discs and refrigerate for an hour. After being allowed to set, heat some teaspoons of butter and oil in a skillet over medium heat, flour the cakes and fry for four minutes or until toasted on both sides. Serve with a well-beaten sauce compiled of mayonnaise, ketchup and Dijon mustard.
